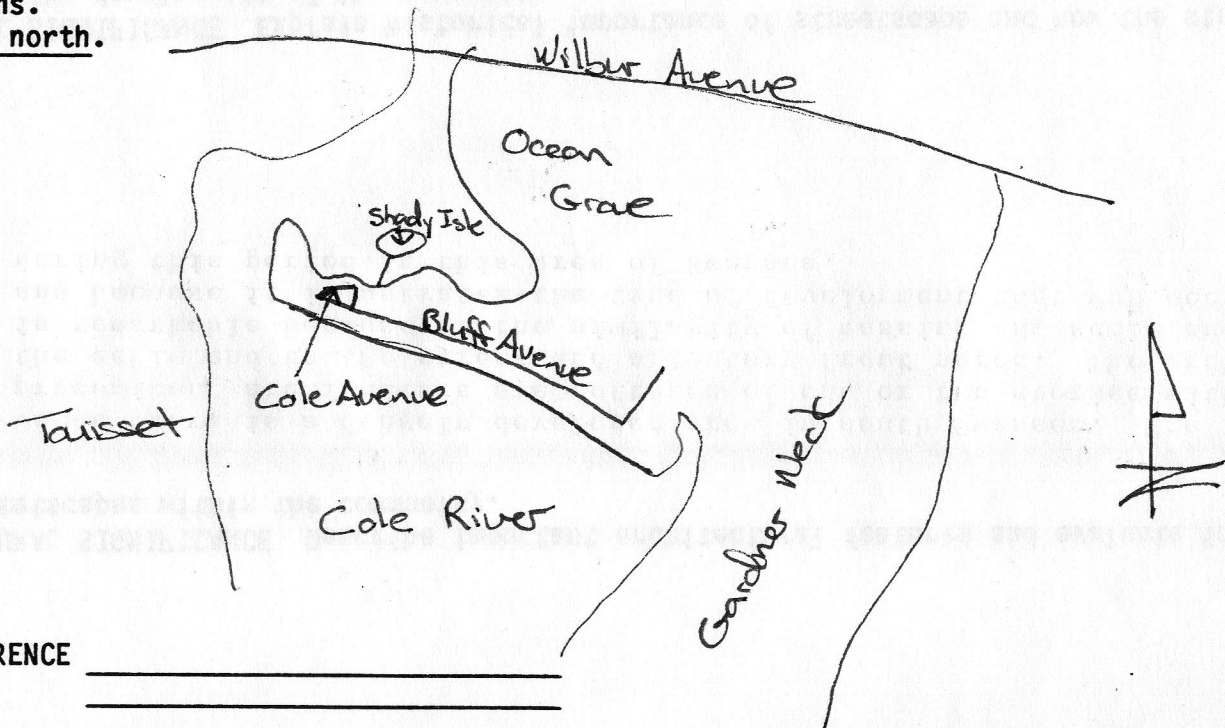

**NATIONAL REGISTER CRITERIA STATEMENT (if applicable)****ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE** Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other streetscapes within the community.

Ocean Grove is a densely developed area in south Swansea. The predominant architecture are cottages of one or two stories with the gable end to the street and a 1-story front porch. The architecture is remarkable because of the similarity of massing and scale and function, and because it illustrates the type of development that was occurring during this period in this area of Swansea.

**HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE** Explain historical importance of streetscape and how the streetscape relates to the development of the community.

This Cole Street Streetscape illustrates the type of development that was dominant in Ocean Grove in the early 20th century.
