ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other streetscapes within the community.

Ocean Grove is a densely developed area in south Swansea. The predominant architecture are cottages of one or two stories with the gable end to the street and a 1-story porch.
