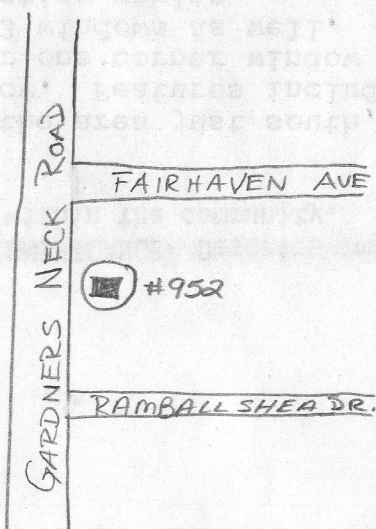

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.

Unlike the area just south, this Queen Anne was used for year-round occupancy. Features include a wrap front porch with rounded side corner. Two over one corner window with stained glass incasing window and large 2 over 2 windows as well. The house is 2-stories with asymmetrical intersecting gables.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.

Typical year-round home of majestic scale for possibly a well-to-do Fall River mill owner.
